

Daisy Doggy bed

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If your dog is going through seasonal depression this winter like my Betty is, then they need this bed. It's a little ray of sunshine to help your pooch perk up. This project is super easy and takes little of your time to make. Seeing your beloved dog napping on a daisy bed will also help bring a smile to your face to battle the winter blahs too!

What you will need:

- Sewing machine
- Pins
- Thread
- Hand sewing needles
- 1M of yellow fabric – use soft and heavy woven fabrics such as fleece, or flannelette.
- 1.5 M of white fleece or flannelette.
- 1 large bag of fiberfill

Cutting:

- Flower center – cut 2 in yellow fabric
- Petals – cut 10 in white fabric

Seam allowance – 3/8"

Construction:

Step 1: Flower center

- First, on the wrong side of one of the flower centers, mark an opening. (Diagram 1)
- With the good sides facing together, stitch both the layers together, leaving the opening unstitched. (Diagram 2)
- Turn right side out.
- Stuff the flower center to your desired fullness. (Diagram 3)
- Close up the opening by hand sewing. (Diagram 4)

Step 2: Petals – there are 5 petals in total. We are going to make each one separately, then attach them to the flower center. That way you can detach the petals for easier cleaning if you need to.

- Mark an opening at the end of the petal. (Diagram 5)
- With the good sides facing together, stitch the petals together all around, leaving the opening unstitched.
- Turn them right side out.
- Stuff the petal to your desired fullness.
- Close up the opening by hand sewing. (Diagram 6)

Step 3: Repeat step 2 for the rest of the petals.

At this point, you should have 5 finished petals and a yellow flower center. (Diagram 7)

Step 4: Hand sew the petals to the edge of the yellow center. Make sure you use a strong thread for extra strength. (Diagram 8)
You are done. Sweet dreams, Poochie!
